

Explore Historic Harwich: Captain Jones Country

Christopher Jones, Master of the Mayflower, was born around 1570 in the historic port of Harwich, Essex on England's east coast.

His ship once carried barrels of wine from France which

made her smell sweet.

Today you can still walk in his footsteps around the town's Kings Head Street.

Visit Christopher Jones' House.
The actual house where he lived now tells the fascinating story of his life and times.

Look up at the historic sailmakers' loft. Imagine heavy sails thrown from its jetty and hauled to the ships moored at the end of the street.

See the Alma Inn - home of Sarah Twitt Christopher Jones' first wife.

Discover the home-town of some of the Mayflower's crew - including John Alden, the first man to step ashore in America.
