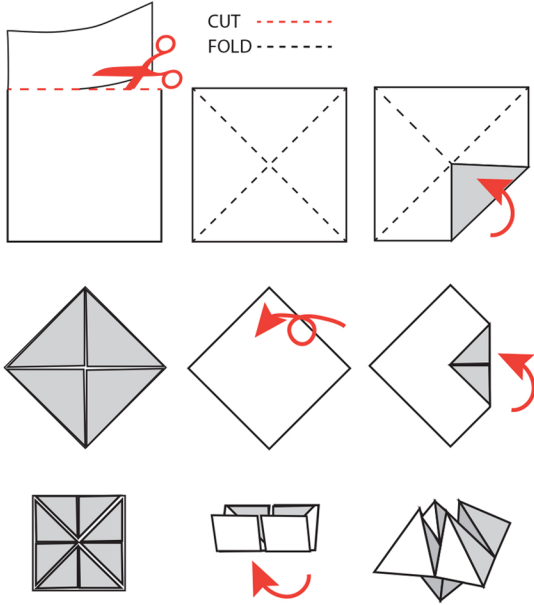


The Mayflower: Fun Facts Game
